4. Qualifications.

(a) Essential.

- (i) Matric or equivalent from recognized Board.
- (ii) Proficiency in handling Private Branch Exchange (PBX) board.(Experience Certificate to be provided)
- (b) **Desirable**. Fluency in spoken English and Hindi.

5. Terms of Engagement.

- (a) New entrants to Government service, entering on or after 01 Jan 2004 are governed by National Pension System.
- (b) The appointment will be on probation for a period of two years followed by permanent absorption subject to found suitable during the probation period.
- (c) As per the Government orders, retention of Government servant beyond 55 years of age/ 30 years of qualifying service (whichever is applicable) will be carried out by screening committee, if found suitable. Government servants whose integrity is doubtful will not be retained. If found suitable for retention, the Government servant will retire from service on attaining age of 60 years.
- (d) The candidate will disqualify for the Government Service in case he or she has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living **OR** who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted another marriage.

- 9. <u>Scheme of Examination</u>. The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit which will be decided as per marks obtained in Written Test comprising of 100 Marks. Applicants shortlisted for written test will also have to undergo a skill test which will be of qualifying in nature and carries no separate marks.
 - (a) <u>Written Test</u>. The written Test will comprise of four parts as given below:

- Note: The question paper will be bilingual i.e. English and Hindi. However, the question of English Language subject will be in English only. No extra weightage will be given for additional/ extra/ higher qualification for recruitment.
- (b) <u>Skill Test.</u> Skill test will be conducted to check candidate's proficiency in handling exchange operation and this will be conducted for qualifying purpose only. Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit of written test subject to candidate qualifying in the skill test.
- (c) If the number of applications received in response to the advertisement are large and it is not convenient or possible to arrange the examination for all the candidates, the selection board reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in the prescribed minimum essential qualification i.e Matric or equivalent.

10. <u>Important Instructions for the Applicants</u>.

- (c) Persons working in Central/ State Govt/ PSU must apply through proper channel along with the certificate from their establishment that no disciplinary action is contemplated/ pending against them and that they have no objection to release them in case of selection.
- (d) The written test and skill test would be held at **Pune, Maharashtra**. Candidates should come prepared to stay for two-three days for completion of the recruitment process. Candidates have to make their own arrangements for boarding/ lodging during the period of stay. No travelling allowance/ dearness allowance would be paid to the candidates called for the examination.
